If you are unable to read on the Sunday you are scheduled, please take the responsibility to trade with someone else. Notify the church office so that the right name is printed in the bulletin as the lay reader for the service.

Please practice reading the lessons out-loud ahead of time so that you are not reading them in front of the congregation for the first time.

When you read for the first time, you may want to come in a little early and practice at the lectern to get yourself comfortable being up front.

On the Sunday you read, sit the pew where you usually sit. When it is time for the lessons, come up to the lectern. When you are finished, you may return to your pew.

Relax. Nobody in the congregation wants you to fail. Your listeners will be impressed that you have the courage to stand up in front of a crowd and read. So again, *relax*. Speak clearly and distinctly. Enunciate!

Readings will be from the English Standard Version of the Bible and will be emailed to you the Tuesday before the Sunday you are reading. If you do not receive the lessons on Tuesday, please let Sue in the church office know so that can be remedied. Please give your e-mail address to Sue in the church office.
